HOLIDAY OPEN HOUSE:

We are having our Holiday Open House the week of December 19, 2016. Each classroom will have a ½ hour to present their songs and holiday treats. Please check the monthly calendar for the time your child's classroom will have Open House. For Holiday parties a sign-up sheet will be posted in the waiting room in advance for any parents who wish to bring in "goodies" or "treats" for their child's class. Put goodies and treats in a container that can be disposed of, and label the container with your child's name and room number. <u>Please DO NOT send in PEANUT BUTTER or small items like NUTS, HARD CANDY, GUM, BALLOONS, etc.</u> Please have your child wear something festive on that day.

Due to space limitations this is for parents only. We will have staff members directing traffic in our main parking lot. Once the front lot is full we will direct parents to the church parking lot. If necessary we will direct parents to find street parking.

TUITION PAYMENTS AND FEES:



Please keep in mind that if you are <u>planning to go on vacation tuition needs</u> to be <u>paid before you go</u>. There is a **<u>\$5.00 per day charge</u>** for <u>late tuition</u> payments.

REMINDER LOST & FOUND:

All families should have their child's name on his/her coats, hats, etc. when entering the school. This helps alleviate any problems with any missing articles of clothing that a child has left behind. If we find an article of clothing **without** a name on it, it will be placed in the waiting room in the **lost and found box**. All unclaimed items left at the end of the month will be given to Goodwill.

INCLEMENT WEATHER & SCHOOL CLOSING:

Call 703-671-5557 for a voicemail recording for school closing.

We do not close for snow days UNLESS the Federal Government closes (this does not mean Liberal or Unscheduled leave). To alleviate some unnecessary phone calls to the school, please remember: (A) We do not follow any county school closings, (B) Liberal/Unscheduled Leaves means, Federal Government is still open but Federal employees can decide whether or not to report to work and (C) Check Federal Government website, <u>www.opm.gov</u>. We follow United States Federal Government; please listen to your local television, radio <u>WTOP 103.5 FM stations</u>, and follow us on Facebook or call 703-671-5557 for a recorded message.

Please do not allow your child/children to wear snow boots or snow suits to school. The children do not go outside in bad weather. However, the children do still go outside for recess and Physical Education class should the weather permit it.

OPEN DOOR POLICIES:

Attention Parents: While Fairfax Academy enjoys an "open door policy" we must insist that parents DO NOT engage in impromptu conferences with the classroom teachers. Your acknowledgement of the student/parent handbook is your agreement to abide with this policy (Rules and Regulation #32). When a teacher engages in a conference it results in a direct violation of Part V Section 22 VAC 15-30-430 Supervision of Children. It states, "when staff are supervising children, they shall <u>always</u> ensure their care, protection and guidance". If you need to speak to your child's teacher, please see someone in the office so that they may relieve the teacher of classroom duties.

SCHOOL REFERRALS:

Remember, whenever a new family that you refer to the school registers, you will receive a **\$50.00** school credit. We ask that the family that was referred put in writing which family referred them.
